

Develop compliance policies and plans to conduct an electrical contracting business

This unit covers the development of plans and policies to ensure regulatory requirements are met in conducting a contracting business, regulator compliance, occupational and workplace relation requirements associated with functions and responsibilities of a contracting business. It encompasses applying knowledge of compliance regulations and standards, legislated obligations in relation to safety, the environment, heritage sites and employment and human resources.

Eligibility for funding

Eligibility

Eligible participants under this program:

1. must be:

- an Australian or New Zealand citizen; or
- a permanent resident of Australia; or
- a holder of a refugee or humanitarian visa

2. and must:

- permanently reside in Queensland; or
- be permanently employed in Queensland

3. and must be:

- an existing worker; and
- an eligible worker¹; or
- an unemployed eligible worker

4. and must not be:

- an employee of any Authority (excluding employees of an Indigenous Council that is a Principal Contractor); or
- eligible under the [CSQ Apprentice Advance+ Program](#); or
- currently enrolled and participating in a school program; or
- a contracted trainer and assessor or existing worker of an RTO; or
- already funded by an Authority or other such source for delivery of the same training being undertaken as part of this program; or
- previously been funded under this program for eight (8) short courses in the same program period.
