SITE TOUR

Site tours of live construction sites offer participants, either students or teachers, a first-hand educational experience to learn about the construction industry and career opportunities.

Location: Live construction site.

Duration: Typically takes approx. 2–3 hours, in the morning.

Partner provides: Company representative. Suitable live construction site.



CONSTRUCTION CHAT

Reps from local construction businesses are welcomed into school settings to showcase the real-world experience of working in the industry and their employer company.

Location: School classroom / hall.

Duration: 30–45 minutes plus time for questions (allow 1 hour). During school hours.

Partner provides: Company representative. Accompanying presentation using CSQ template.



TRY'A TRADE

Try'a Trade events aim to raise awareness of careers in construction by providing students with hands-on activities and advice from industry experts.

Location: Live construction site.

Duration: Varies, but typically run between 9am–2pm.

Partner provides: Suitable site.



TRY'A SKILL

Try'a Skill events aim to raise awareness of lesser-known non-trade careers in construction through hands-on activities to experience different professions.

Location: Live construction site.

Duration: Varies, but typically run between 9am–2pm.

Partner provides: Suitable live construction site. Qualified staff to guide activities.



WORK EXPERIENCE

Work experience gives students meaningful exposure to roles in a construction workplace helping them to make more informed career choices.

Location: Construction business workplace.

Duration: Placements typically run for five days from Monday–Friday and students cannot exceed 30 days in a calendar year.

Partner provides: Supervisor. Interesting activities.
