



What is an **Architectural Drafter?**

An architectural drafter works closely with builders and clients to create plans and drawings used to construct buildings and other structures.

What does the **job** involve?

- **Creating** designs, sketches, plans and analysing design projects
- **Depicting** building and element elevations
- **Selecting** building materials
- **Using** computer-aided drafting design techniques and programs
- **Ensuring** architects and other workers follow specifications and plans
- **Working** with clients for approval on projects

How do I get into this career?

You usually need a formal qualification in building design or residential drafting to work as an architectural drafter. A Diploma and Advanced Diploma is often required. An interest and skills in maths, IT and design is also important.
