A building designer is responsible for the creative, efficient design of residential and commercial buildings. They may work for builders, or directly for the client.

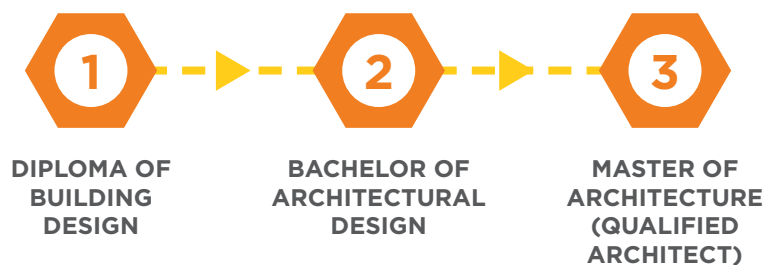
What does the **job involve?**

- **Meeting** with clients to take and understand the design brief
- **Designing** and interpreting plans
- **Undertaking** feasibility studies
- **Researching** and understanding council codes, codes of practice and industry regulations
- **Coordinating** submissions to council
- **Preparing** contracts and ensuring terms are followed
- **Working** with clients to discuss progress, challenges and project milestones
- **Overseeing** suppliers, contractors and resources, and supervising the site

How do I get into this career?

While building designers don't require specific qualifications in Australia, holding a qualification in building design may give you an advantage.
