Civil Construction Superintendents ensure projects are delivered successfully and on time. They collaborate with engineers and subcontractors to define project needs and oversee staff performance.

## What does the job involve?

- **Collaborate** with engineers, subcontractors, etc. to determine project needs
- **Plan** construction processes
- **Estimate** costs and ensure the project is on budget
- **Supervise** staff and provide constructive feedback
- **Monitor** and report on project progress
- **Implement** safety and quality guidelines
