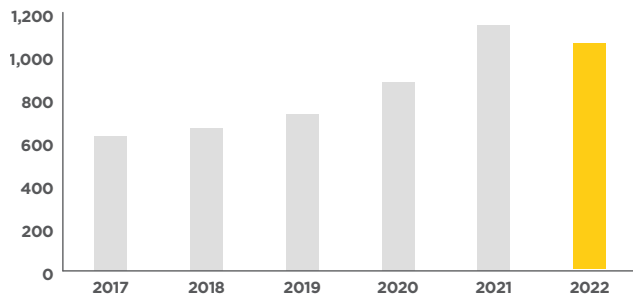

Value of building approvals (\$m), 12 months to June

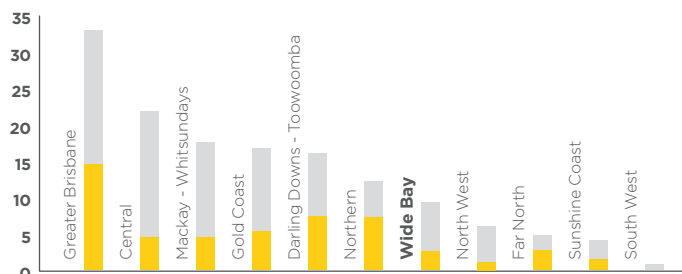

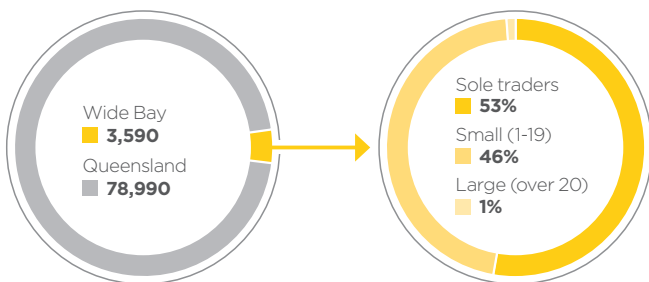

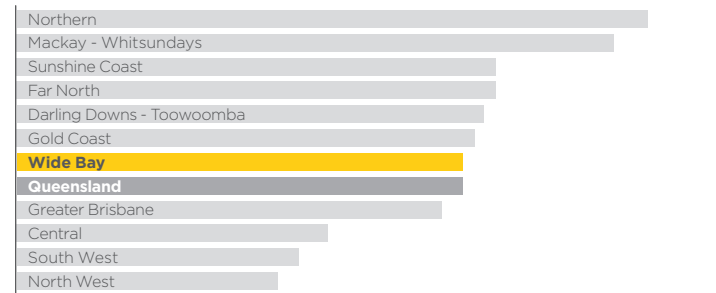

Apprentice training rate

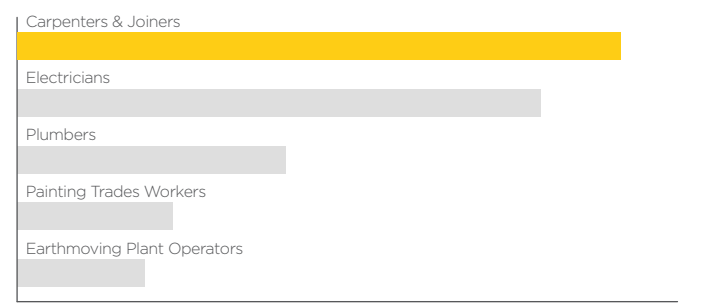
Construction apprentices in-training per hundred workers
