History of Procurement at CSQ

Traditionally, from June to September each year, CSQ procured training services as part of the Training Plan cycle via a Request for Tender process

While process improvements & learnings have been embedded each year, there hasn't been a significant review & reform of CSQ's procurement activities for some time

In 2022, a procurement reform project was instigated, with the intent to reshape the future state of CSQ procurement

Why Reform CSQ's Procurement

Reliance on an annual RFT process

Time consuming for both Suppliers & CSQ

Not delivering value or cost effective outcomes for CSQ, industry, & suppliers

Minor changes in annual list of suppliers despite time consuming repetitive processes each year

Reform will allow CSQ the flexibility in responding to industry & regional priorities



What does the future state of procurement look like?

Supplier rationalization

Establishment of a Panel of Suppliers

Discontinuation of the annual RFT process

Implementation of a new contract management system



What does this all mean?

Registered Training Supplier & Pre-approved Provider status will be discontinued & replaced by a Panel of preferred suppliers

Transition from the annual RFT process to a strategic & agile allocation of funding , supported by targeted RFTs as and when required

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Benefits of Reform

Improve efficiencies by removing waste associated with annual RFT's for CSQ, industry, & suppliers

Enable CSQ to respond to strategic & local industry needs more effectively & efficiently

Provide greater flexibility to procure service delivery in sectoral & emerging skills
